According to the idea of the head of our country Sh.M. Mirziyoyev, who stated that our youth is capable of serving the development of the country and realizing the "Uzbekistan-2035" strategy, this programmatic document defined the tasks for Uzbekistan to reach the ambitious goal of entering the ranks of the most advanced countries in the world. "As a first step, great attention is being paid to increasing exports and investments. I can boldly say that today we are on the threshold of the "Uzbek miracle". This is not only a dream, but a reality-axiom that does not require proof.

A miracle is such a discovery-reality that its appearance in space and time affects the development of society, and even transforms it into a new self, it is a force capable of making revolutionary changes. Deep reforms being carried out in Uzbekistan are assessed by

The declaration of 2021 as the "Year of Youth Support and Public Health Promotion" in our country is another practical expression of this.

"It is known that young people tend to think in a new way, boldly come up with new ideas and implement them, solve problems based on creative and non-standard approaches. Therefore, at present, we give priority to the creation of all conditions for representatives of the younger generation to acquire knowledge, to reveal their talents and potential in the fields of science, innovation, literature, art and sports, and for their active participation in the social and political life of our society," said the honorable President Sh.M. Mirziyoev in his interview to the editor-in-chief of "New Uzbekistan" newspaper. Continuing his remarks, the head of state emphasizes that we have started great work in this direction.

The number of universities in our country for the purpose of training competitive personnel with high knowledge and qualifications has increased to 141, branches of 26 foreign higher education institutions have been opened. However, in 2016, the number of universities in our republic was 77. In the next five years, the admission quota for higher education was increased 3 times, and this year 182,000 young people had the opportunity to become a student. This means that the total coverage reached 28 percent. For comparison, 4 years ago this figure was only 9 percent.

Within the framework of the "Five Important Initiatives" program and "Berkamol Avlod" centers, 36,000 additional clubs were organized this year, and about 874,000 children were involved in them. Also, about 100,000 art and sports inventories, computers, and about 600,000 books were delivered to educational institutions, libraries and educational centers.

Today, the implementation of ideas and initiatives of young people in the field of entrepreneurship, providing them with a source of work and income is given great importance at the state level. Thanks to such attention, the number of entrepreneurs under the age of 30 has increased fivefold and exceeded 500,000 in the last four years, playing an important role in the development of this industry. This year alone, preferential loans of 2 trillion 300 billion soums have been allocated for business projects of more than 92 thousand young people, which will serve to further expand the ranks of such young people. We can cite many such facts and figures from our daily social and domestic life.

In short, Uzbekistan has proved that it is following the absolutely correct, and at the same time, renewing strategic path in almost five years. Honorable President Shavkat Mirziyoyev expressed high confidence in the youth in particular: "Our youth are the main force that will
